

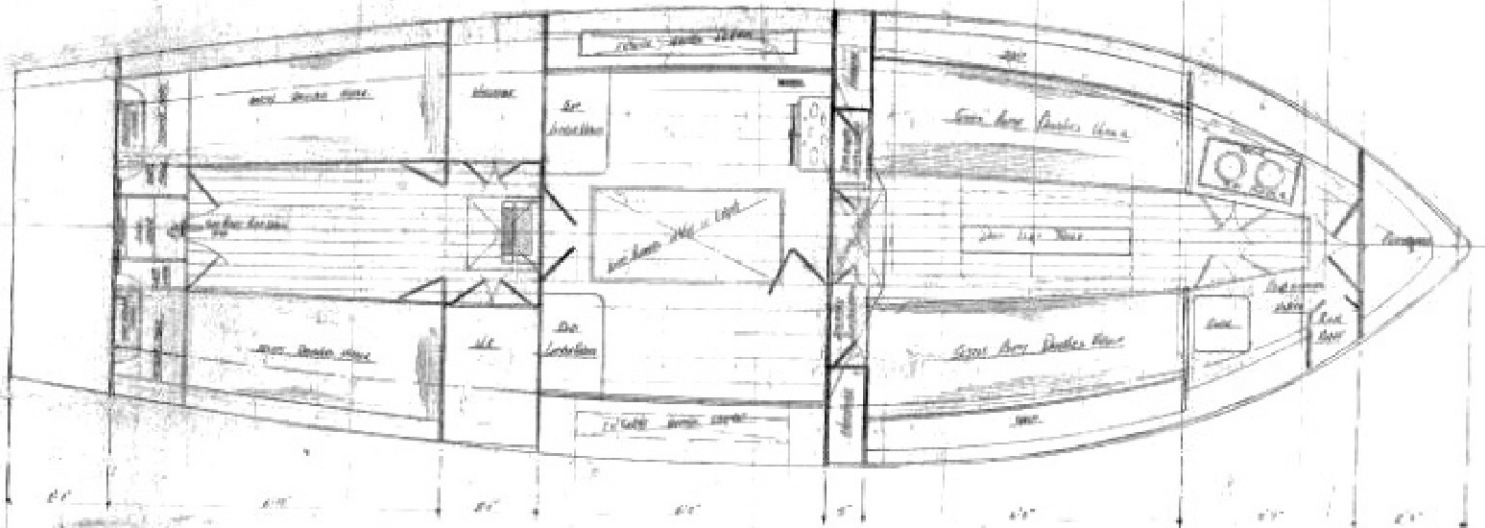
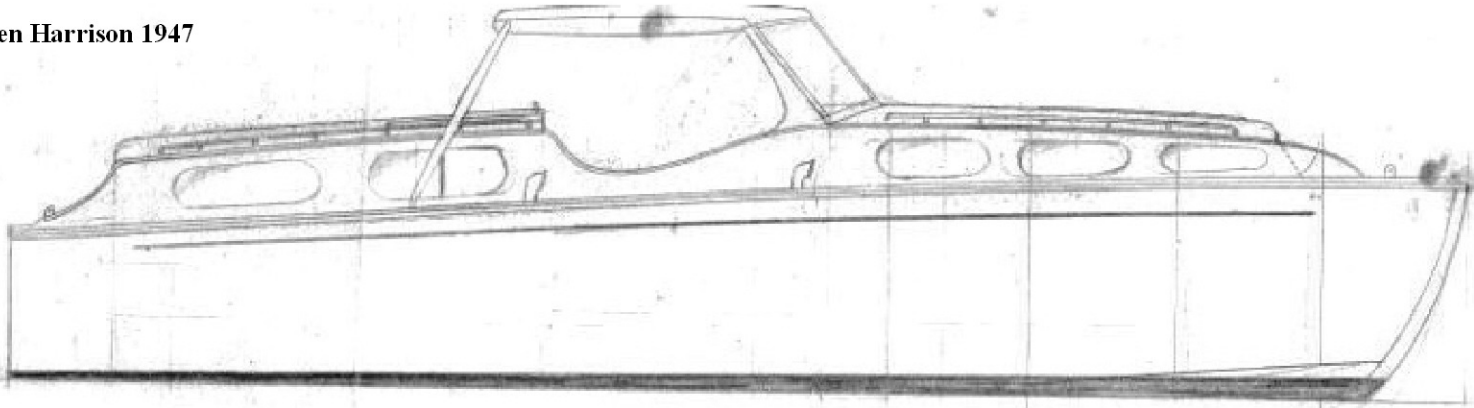

- Length.** 30ft.
- Beam.** 9ft. 8ins.
- Draught.** 2ft. 6ins.
- Headroom.** 6ft.
- Power.** 12/24 h.p. Morris "Navigator" marine engine with self-starter.
- Cooking.** Gas stove with oven in separate galley with sink.
- Lighting.** Electric.
- Berths.** Five single berths.

Other features. Two cabins separated by central cockpit which is fitted with a collapsible canopy, windscreen and side curtains. Ample drawer and locker accommodation. Flushing W.C. in separate compartment. Large freshwater tank. Dinghy provided.
